

Milton School Committee
Retreat
October 7, 2005
Minutes

In attendance: Glenn Pavlicek, Paul Hogan, Chris Huban,, Mary Kelly, Beirne Lovely, and Laurie Stillman

Chairman Pavlicek called the meeting to order at 8:10am. A motion was made to suspend policy CBI and not use CBI-R as the evaluation tool by which to assess the superintendent's performance. The motion was duly seconded, and a roll call vote yielded a unanimous vote in the affirmative.

A discussion ensued about how to proceed with the superintendent's evaluation. It was agreed that the Chairman would present a consensus statement of the school committee at a regularly scheduled televised session, consisting of a qualitative evaluation, without a numerical scale. The following topics were then discussed concerning the superintendent's performance:

- a) Special Education
- b) Standards based environment
- c) Math, FLES and Data analysis will be grouped together because it was felt that there wasn't sufficient information to provide comment on each of them separately
- d) Community/parental/school community communication and engagement—the school committee will meet in January to evaluate progress on this important area.
- e) Facilities Maintenance
- f) Student Achievement
- g) Financial Management

Chair Glenn Pavlicek and Vice Chair Chris Huban will present feedback to the superintendent in a meeting prior to the televised session so that there will be no surprises.

A motion was made and duly seconded to adjourn the meeting. The vote was unanimous and the meeting adjourned at 9:45am.
