 - Added Professional Development for curriculum and assessment materials
- Closing the Proficiency Gaps
 - Stipends for summer teaching and extended learning
 - Expanded student assessment software
 - Added Professional Development for strategies to close Proficiency Gaps
 - Purchased materials for extended day programs

 - Hired half time Middle and High School Science coordinators

Advancement Initiatives 2.0

- Enhancing Early Literacy Achievement
 - Increase reading specialist support for Pre-K and Grade
 3
 - Continue implementation of Reader's/Writer's
 Workshop and provide professional development in K-5
 - Purchase leveled non-fiction readers for K-5 classrooms
- Closing the Proficiency Gaps
 - Provide professional development in targeted/tiered instruction for subgroups in particular
 - Provide professional development in assessment (including PARCC) and using data to inform instruction
 - Support implementation of targeted support programs (Elem. Before/After School, Elem. Summer, Pierce Academy, Calculus Project, etc.)

Advancement Initiatives 2.0 (cont'd)

- Advancing Science and STEM
 - Purchase science kits for K-5 and Grade 3 STEM
 - Purchase materials to continue STEM initiative and expand robotics opportunities at Pierce Middle School and Milton High School
 - Upgrade/replace science equipment at Milton High School to keep pace with changing technologies in STEM
 - Expand Pierce Middle School and Milton High School
 Science Department Heads from part-time to full-time
 - Provide professional development (K-12) in science instruction and content

- Supporting All Three Initiatives
 - Hire a district-wide data specialist / digital education coordinator
 - Hire parent outreach / family liaison
