

Elementary Student Assignment Policy

In April 2007 the Milton School Committee voted to retain four K-5 elementary schools, with the PreK at the Collicot School.

Students entering the Milton Public Schools are assigned to one of the four elementary schools based upon their address according to the street listing developed in June 2007.

There are exceptions to this general rule:

- 1. The administration reserves the right to assign students to schools other than their home school for the purpose of maintaining advantageous class sizes.**
- 2. Entering students with an older sibling who will be attending the same school the following September may be "grandfathered" into that school, regardless of the street address.**
 - a. Example: Gulliver Street was formerly assigned to the Glover district. Beginning in September 2007 Gulliver Street is assigned to the Cunningham School. An entering student with an older sibling who currently attends and will continue to attend the Glover School may be assigned to that same school. However, entering students with no older sibling will be assigned to the Cunningham School. Thus, it is possible for neighbors to attend different schools.**
- 3. In the event that particular programs become over subscribed in a particular school (s), the administration reserves the right to assign students to schools other than their home schools for the purpose of accommodating their choice of program. Students are guaranteed their choice of program; they are not guaranteed their choice of school. In cases where students are to be assigned based upon their program preference, parents may request to have the student(s) reassigned to a different program and thus, remain in the home school.**

Students who are reassigned for either class size issues or programmatic choice, will follow the same guidelines for transportation as do all other students.
