Future Stars is a reading program designed to help develop good reading skills and self-image and build a bridge between high school and elementary students. Under the supervision of Coach Green, students will be grouped by grade and work with student athletes, who will run reading and sports clinics stressing the fundamentals of athletics while sharing the importance of reading and the rewards that come from accomplishment. After reading sessions, students will hold open discussions and talk about issues and myths surrounding reading. Sports clinics will involve all the students, whether they have lots of experience with sports or none at all. Strong reading skills and high self-esteem are important to children's development, and a bridge between older and younger citizens is a positive force for our community.
