  - 2011-12 no lottery necessary
    - 9 classes of English & 7 classes of French

#### **School Assignment Timeline**

- February 29<sup>th</sup> Program choice forms were due to the school offices.
- March 22<sup>nd</sup> Parents/guardians will be notified if their child has been assigned to a school/program or if their child's name will be entered into a tiered lottery system.
- March 26<sup>th</sup> School based lotteries will be held.
- March 27<sup>th</sup> Families will be notified of lottery results and options for assignment.
- March 30<sup>th</sup> Families must select option for school/program assignment
- After March 30<sup>th</sup> Students new to the district in Grade 1 will be assigned.
