Personnel

- Restore 1.0 FTE English Teacher
- Add I.0 FTE History Teacher
- Humanities Department Head into English and History Department Heads
- Add I.0 FTE Health Teacher
- Add I.0 FTE Science Teacher to advance STEM (Engineering, Oceanography, Astronomy, others)
- Add 0.2 FTE French or Latin
- Add I.0 FTE Mathematics (Alternative Education)
- Add I.0 FTE Special Education Teacher
- Add I.0 FTE Inclusion Specialist (Support for Co-Teaching Model)
- Add 0.5 FTE Attendance Officer
- Restore 0.5 FTE Guidance Counselor
- Restore 0.5 FTE College Application/Community Service Coordinator
- Add I.0 FTE Adjustment Counselor (Transitions Program)

Programs & Initiatives

Transitions Program

- Short-term service for students returning to MHS after a crisis or extended absence due to illness, injury or hospitalization
- Helps students and their families with re-entry and reintegration to school by supporting their academic, social and emotional needs
- Tailored to the individual's unique set of needs as he or she transitions to a full schedule
- Participation usually lasts up to eight weeks
- Goal is to facilitate a seamless and manageable reentry that supports students and families, minimizes stress and encourages academic and social success at school



Programs & Initiatives

Transitions Program

- Re-entry to school can be overwhelming for a stu-dent who has faced an extended absence, especially after managing significant medical or mental health issues. The Adjustment Counselor in the Transition's Program will:
 - Provide support in preparation for returning to a full class schedule
 - Act as a liaison with families, teachers and other support services at the school
 - ▶ Help improve and stabilize attendance and academic performance
 - Offer a supportive learning environment
 - Encourage resilience and coping skills
 - Provide crisis support for students who are struggling, and
 - Communicate with and provide referrals for outside treatment providers
- When enrollment is low in the Program, the Adjustment Counselor will provide additional support for the other Adjustment Counselors at MHS

Texts, Materials & Supplies

- Purchase of History Texts to replace online text (expiring subscription)
- Replace Spanish Books

Technology & Technology Support

Technology Replacement Plan

- Teacher computers
- SmartBoards
 - Add SmartBoards to Library, Music & Child Study
- Projectors
- Student computers/tablets/chromebooks/ipads
- Photocopier (Replacement & Add to Library)

Increase Technology Support

- Increased support for Help Desk
- Routine maintenance and updates (vs. reactive repair)
- Support for "back end" of Student Information Systems (including AdminPlus, Gradebooks, Edline, GoogleAdmin)
- Regular Professional Development by Technology Staff for other Faculty/Staff on any/all of our computer-based systems

Reduction of Fees

- Eliminate Athletic User Fees
 - ▶ \$250 per sport (except Ice Hockey & Crew)
- Eliminate Club/Activity Fees
 - ▶ \$50 for one club; \$100 for two or more clubs
