Farm to School


 Farm to School continues in the Milton School Food Service Program. Purchased \$10,176 this year.

- Mailed letters home to all free and reduced students encouraging them to eat breakfast at school
- Daily choices include whole grain muffins, whole grain cereals, whole grain pancakes or whole grain French toast, fresh fruit, 100% juice and milk.
- This year we introduced hot cocoa at the high school to encourage more students to drink milk
