

CURRENT AND ON GOING ENERGY CONSERVATION MEASURES

- Completed Energy Management System upgrades to High School and Pierce Middle School, such as Demand side Control Ventilation/Control Programing (estimated yearly savings is approximately \$15,000 (\$40,000 Grant Money)
- Received energy grant of \$20,000 to purchase new 28 watt 4' florescent light bulbs to replace existing 32 watt light bulbs (anticipated yearly savings \$3,000)
- We are currently working with a third party energy consultants to investigate additional energy options through Schools and Town Buildings.
- Indoor/Outdoor Lighting Retrofits, such as LED Interior and Parking Lot Fixtures
- Variable Speed Drives & Motors on Boilers
