### ***For students entering grades 1-3***

Students entering grades 1-3 will have summer math calendars to work on. These calendars will be posted on the district website as well as your school page. The activities in our summer math calendars will review concepts and skills that have been completed during the 2016-2017 school year. We ask that your child choose at least 18 of the 24 activities listed for each month to complete. Circle each box as you complete it. The EM4 games listed under play are all games that your child has engaged in at school and they are easy to play at home. Spending a few minutes each day thinking and talking about math will help reinforce skills learned as well as continue to build the foundation for mathematical success in the coming school year. We hope that you have fun with the activities and make sure to have children share their thinking and reasoning with people in your family.

### ***For students entering grades 4 & 5***

Throughout the summer months, students entering grades 4 & 5 are asked to go onto Study Island and their school link to Everyday Math. These sites will engage students in math thinking while reinforcing concepts that students have learned throughout the year. They are a fun way to practice math and to ensure that students continue to grow mathematically over the summer.
