• By spring 2016 the District's CPI gaps between African American/Black, High Needs, Special Education, and Low Income students and their counterparts will be on target to reduce the achievement gap by half by 2017. (See attached 2016 Gap goals)

- Reduce participation gaps in various areas including Sports, Clubs and Advanced Placement Courses including Sub-Groups and by French-English programs by fiscal year-end 2016.
- Implement a comprehensive plan for all students in Grades K-12 to educate, assess and support the health, social/emotional well-being and life skill preparation beginning in January 2016.
- Develop and execute Elementary school marketing plans that document program offerings, communicate academic success and generate/sustain demand by calendar year-end 2015.
