Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Milton School Committee is launching a search for a new Superintendent for the Milton Public Schools. There are a number of ways that parents/guardians can participate in the process. We value your perspective and hope you will be able to take advantage of the following opportunities.

Screening Committee Parent/Guardian Volunteers

A Superintendent Screening Committee is being formed to review and interview applicants and recommend 2-3 finalist candidates to the School Committee. The School Committee will then interview and appoint a new Superintendent.

There are three (3) seats available for parents/guardians to serve on the Screening Committee. School Committee members who are not on the Screening Committee will review the submissions from parent/guardian volunteers and make a selection and recommendation to the School Committee.

In order to participate in this process, volunteers who serve on the Screening Committee must be available to attend ALL meetings according to the following dates and times:
