TRANSPORTATION: There will be a late bus <u>with limited stops</u> for <u>bus students only</u> on Wednesdays and Thursdays **ONLY-** beginning the week of <u>September 24, 2018</u>. Course Descriptions

*** "Borde" Games

Mondays (2:30-3:25) (Instructor: Mrs. Borde-Room 215)

<u>Course Description:</u> Do you ever wish you had a group of friends to play board games with? We will have a variety of games available each week. Students will break up into groups of 2-6 (depending on the game) and enjoy playing games each week. Possible games include: Apples to Apples, Pictionary, Connect Four, Battleship, and Various Card Games.

***Flag Football

Mondays (2:30-3:25) (Coach- Mr. E. – back field)

<u>Course Description:</u> Boys and girls are welcome! Students will learn some skills in the game of football and have fun! Everyone plays!

***Pierce Fitness

Tuesdays (2:30-3:25) (Instructor: Mr. O'Leary-weight room)

<u>Course Description:</u> Using the Pierce Middle School fitness room and facilities, students will learn proper form and technique when using Nautilus equipment/Keiser equipment, resistance bands and exercise balls. Students will also work on improving their cardiovascular fitness through a variety of games and activities.

***Pierce Middle School Soccer Program (Please note: This class runs two days until 4PM. Cost= \$100)

Tuesdays and Fridays (2:30-4:00) (Coach- Mr. E.- back field)

<u>Course Description:</u> Whether you are a beginner or highly skilled, the Pierce Soccer Program is the place where you can develop your skills, foster team work, and even have a friendly game or two with the high school!

***Flag Rugby

Wednesdays (2:30-3:25) (Instructor: Mr. Dolan-back field)

<u>Course Description:</u> Play flag rugby! Learn the basics of rugby: rules, passing, kicking, teamwork, and have fun playing America's fastest growing sport. No contact or tackling involved. Boys and girls welcome, all ages, shapes and sizes welcome! Supervised by Mr. Joe Dolan, Head Coach, Milton High School Rugby Club. Outdoor activity; sneakers or cleats, comfortable clothing.

***Books Made Into Movies

Wednesdays (2:30-3:25) (Instructor: Mrs. Borde-Room 215)

<u>Course Description:</u> We will generate a list of books that were made into movies and choose which ones to watch. Most movies will take two meetings to complete. We will have group discussions about each movie at its completion. Possible titles include: Bridget to Terabithia, Holes, The Great Gilly Hopkins, A Wrinkle in Time, The Maze Runner, The Lightning Thief.

***eCybermission Challenge [Please note this class runs 16 weeks. Cost: \$100]

Wednesdays (2:30-3:25) (Instructor: Mrs. Magill-Room 128)

<u>Course Description:</u> eCYBERMISSION is a web-based science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) competition for students in grades six through nine. Students are challenged to explore how STEM works in their world while working as a team to solve problems in their community. Teams of 3-4 students in the same grade compete virtually in state and regional competitions and inperson, if they win their state and regional competitions, through the National Judging & Educational Event (NJ&EE) in June 2019. Student prizes are awarded at the state, regional, and national levels by grade level. Please note this program runs for 16 weeks.

***Pierce Green Team

Thursdays (2:30-3: 25) (Instructor: Ms. Hupp- meet at Room 204)

<u>Course Description:</u> Learn to garden in the amazing Pierce Outdoor Classroom! You'll harvest vegetables, plant bulbs, and learn how to bring plants to life!

***Lego Robotics

Thursdays (2:30-3:25) (Instructor: Mr. Romeo-Room 319)

<u>Course Description:</u> Students in this pass class will be challenged to collaboratively build, design, and program robots using wireless technology. This class is for anyone who loves Legos. No experience required.
