- ❖ All four programs will implement a common curriculum-***The Creative Curriculum*** taught by certified teachers.
- ❖ All students have the opportunity to engage in the core content areas of Math, English Language Arts, Science & Social Studies aligned with Massachusetts Curriculum Frameworks.
- ❖ Social skill building throughout the school day utilizing the Second Step Social Skills Curriculum.
- ❖ All four programs have a small ratio of students to adults.
- ❖ All four programs have unique opportunities to interact with the larger school community.
- ❖ All four programs have a set tuition with an option of tuition assistance for income eligible families.
- ❖ All programs follow the 2019-2020 Milton Public Schools Academic Calendar for Kindergarten students.
- ❖ All programs require pre-registration. Once accepted into a program, formal registration will be required. The pre-registration form can be found at the following link [2019-2020 Pre-registration link](#)
- ❖ If there is high enrollment indicated by pre-registration, programs will hold lotteries. Multiples (twins, triplets, etc.) will be treated as one entry into the lottery but each student will incur an individual tuition cost. Waiting lists will be maintained for each program.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students attend five half day sessions, in either AM or PM (8:30-11:00 or 12:00-2:30) • Age 3 or 4 <i>on or before</i> 8/31 (Children receiving special education services may enter during the year when they turn 3 per the IEP Team process) • Tuition: \$3,350 for each student, with reduced fees available based on a sliding fee scale; students with disabilities may be eligible at no fee • Approximately 15 students attend each class session. Classes include students with and without disabilities • Students are invited to participate in developmentally appropriate school-wide assemblies and events <p>Special Education Programs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Integrated Preschool Programs • A Substantially Separate Program is available for students with intensive needs, as identified by an IEP Team 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students attend three full day sessions, (7:30AM-2:10PM) M/W/F • Age 4 <i>on or before</i> 8/31 only • Tuition: \$4,000 for each student, with reduced fees available based on a sliding fee scale • Milton High School students apply their child development studies in this on-site pre-kindergarten classroom, while taking Child Study, an MHS elective • 15 students attend with the support of junior and senior Milton High School students who work closely with preschoolers facilitated by a certified teacher • Children participate in community-based field trips and other developmentally appropriate experiences at the high school 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students attend five half-day sessions in either AM or PM (8:50-11:30; 12:30-3:19) • Students have the option to attend before or after school programs • Age 3 or 4 <i>on or before</i> 8/31 • Tuition: \$3,350 for each student, with reduced fees available based on a sliding fee scale • Approximately 12 students attend each session 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students attend five full day sessions (8:50 AM to 3:19 PM) • Students have the option to attend before and after school programs • Age 4 <i>on or before</i> 8/31 only • Tuition: \$8,000 with reduced fees available based on a sliding fee scale • Breakfast, Lunch and one snack will be provided • Approximately 18 students can be enrolled in the program. • The district reserves some seats for economically disadvantaged students
