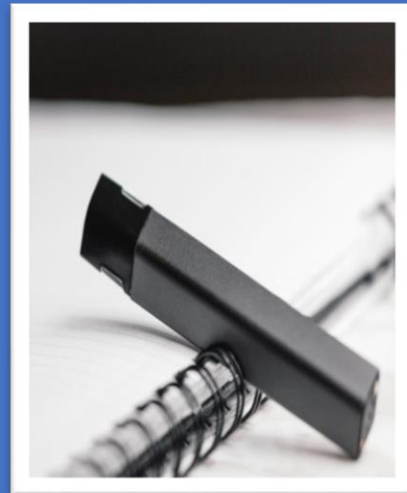

Caron Treatment Centers’ Student Assistance Program will provide an educational presentation on vaping and e-cigarettes for parents/community members in Milton. This program is intended for an adult-audience.

“Vaping” is a term introduced by the electronic nicotine delivery system (ENDS) industry to refer to any electronic vaporizer, also known as E-cigs, vapes, vape pens and E-hookahs. Though originally designed as harm reduction products for cigarette smokers, they have recently morphed into a trend that is becoming increasingly popular with youth. This rise in use is of concern for health professionals, educators and parents; in part because of the common misconception that these products are harmless and because long-term consequences are still not known.

### **Presentation Objectives:**

- Provide information on the effects and consequences of electronic vaping products
- Empower parents and community members with effective communication skills when talking with young people about these products
- Review the importance of establishing clear rules and consequences at home regarding substance use
- Evaluate resiliency factors that help protect young people from substance use
- Provide local resources should community members require addiction support
