Some of the information you may need to complete your application:

Student and Parent (if applicable) Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID) - (FAFSA filers)

Student and Parent (if applicable) Social Security number

If not a US citizen, your A-number (if you are an eligible noncitizen)

Parent's federal income tax return from tax year 2020

Records of untaxed income (such as child support, TANF, interest income, veterans non-education benefits, Social Security benefits)

Student's 2020 federal income tax return, or evidence of income earned (W-2 form or pay records)

Bank account records or statements

Records of stocks, bonds, or investments

Business records
