Enjoy seasonal family fun by visiting three historic estates in the Blue Hills. The Eustis Estate, Wakefield Estate, and Eleanor Cabot Bradley Estate present special events throughout the day.

Celebrate the final weekend of the special exhibition Changing Landscape: Sculpture at the Eustis Estate. See outdoor sculptures throughout the property and join a drop-in sculpture-making workshop with artist Madeleine Lord. There will be family crafts, a cider-making demo and apple tasting, and lawn games throughout the day. Enjoy the peace of the landscape with mindful walking sessions. Foliage tickets must be purchased from each location (advanced tickets not required). Children under 18 get free admission and must be accompanied by an adult. Your ticket helps support programming at these three nonprofit historic sites.

At the Trustees' Eleanor Cabot Bradley Estate, located at 2468 Washington Street in Canton, the main house will be opened to visitors to check out their new decor while taking in the setting of the soon-to-be-released movie- Little Women. At 11AM and 1PM visitors can take a tour of the beautiful trees on the property with horticulture assistant, Frances Kilmurray. Colorful foliage and the beauty of barks, berries and evergreen forms will take center stage. Enjoy a relaxing walk along the scenic trails, purchase plants to add to your own garden, experience the fun of yard games, and take home a free Trustees tote with the purchase of a Trustees membership.

At the Wakefield Estate and Arboretum, guided walks will be featured through its unique arboretum and grounds, including its new dwarf conifer collection that features over 50 species of conifers, at 11:00am, 12:00pm and 1:00pm; caramel apple-making for kids and cider for adults, and nature-based crafts and activities for the whole family.
