



SAT Prep Courses at *Milton High School*

Spring 2018

Milton High School is pleased to offer preparatory courses for the 2018 SAT to students who are looking to improve their scores. Students can sign up for a **Reading, Writing, & Language Prep course**, a **Math Prep course**, or **both courses**. Each course is held at Milton High School and is designed to prepare students for the **May 5th SAT Exam**.

Tuesdays (eight 1.5-hour sessions): March 6, 13, 20, 27; April 3, 10, 24; May 1

Saturday (six 2-hour sessions): March 3, 10, 17, 24; April 7, 28

Cost: \$85 for one course; \$160 for two courses

SAT Math

Tuesdays 4:00-5:30pm
Saturdays 10:00-12:00pm

This course provides students with review topics within the following areas of mathematics: Heart of Algebra (linear equations and systems), Problem Solving and Data Analysis, Passport to Advanced Math, and additional topics which include Geometry and Trigonometry. The course also includes advice on exam-taking techniques.

This course provides students with a review of verbal understanding, reading comprehension, and evidence-based reading and writing. The course also includes advice on exam-taking techniques.
