What is Circle-S?

Circle-S is a unique and exciting, FREE support group serving children whose siblings have a disability.

Children (age 6-18) come with their parent and enjoy a pizza supper, and join other "typical sibs" who face similar experiences of living with a brother or sister with special needs.

Parents have the opportunity to meet and make connections with other parents in a safe, confidential environment. They can speak honestly about the joys and challenges of raising a child with special needs, while also raising a "typical" child.
