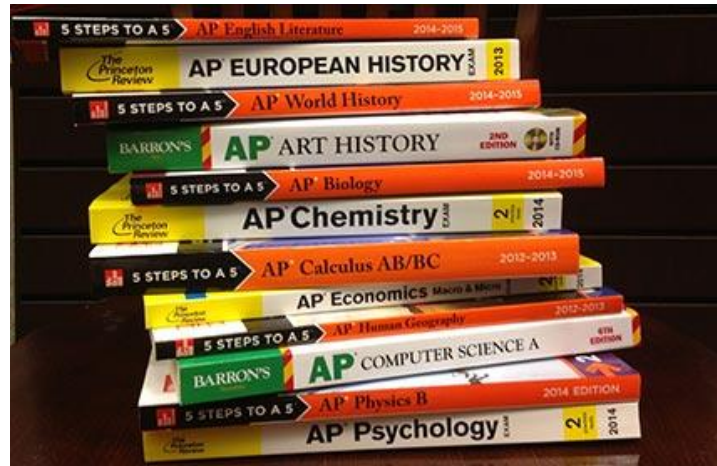

GENERAL ASSESSMENT DATA



- We offered a total of 21 AP courses in 2017-2018.
- 300+ students took at least one AP course last year
- We had more than 700 AP exams taken last year.
- 87% of all AP test taken had a qualifying score (3, 4, or 5)
- DELF – 100% success (51 students)
