

Milton School Food Service Program- September 1, 2020

Hybrid feeding:

Elementary- All students will be offered meals as they are leaving the building on the days they are in attendance. Monday and Tuesday students may receive up to three breakfasts and three lunches to go. Thursday and Friday students may receive up to four breakfasts and four lunches to go. Meals will be free to all students through December 2020. If a USDA waiver is not extended students accounts will be charged accordingly. Meals will remain free for our free and reduced students. Meals will be consumed at home.

Middle and High School-All students will be offered meals as they are leaving the building on the days they are in attendance. Each day student's will receive up to two breakfasts and two lunches to go. Meals will be free to all students through December 2020. If a USDA waiver is not extended students accounts will be charged accordingly. Meals will remain free for our free and reduced students. Meals will be consumed at home.

Remote feeding:

We will provide a drive through model (similar to what we have been doing this past summer) which will offer seven breakfasts and seven lunches to our students at a weekly distribution location. Meals will be free to all students through December 2020. If a waiver is not extended students accounts will be charged accordingly. Meals will remain free for our free and reduced students. Meals will be consumed at home. This drive through is open to both hybrid and remote learners. Hybrid students can take meals at their schools **OR** at the drive through weekly.

Please note:

Our free meal program that we have been operating under, the seamless summer operation, SSO, is only approved through December, 2020. DESE has applied for a waiver for this program to possibly continue throughout the 2020-2021 school year. If this is approved the USDA will once again allow us to serve up to seven breakfast and seven lunches to our students.
