What can my child do if they play an instrument in the Milton Public Schools?

- After taking one year of lessons, your child can be part of the Grade 5 Band or Strings Program at their respective Elementary Schools.
- At Pierce Middle School, your child can be a part of the 6th, 7th, or 8th grade band or orchestra as well as part of the Pierce Jazz Band and the Pierce Chamber Orchestra. They will also have the opportunity to audition for music festivals.
- At Milton High School, your student will have the opportunity to be part of the String Orchestra, one of the two Concert Bands, the Jazz Ensemble, the Wildcat Marching Band as well as a variety of String and Band Chamber Groups and Jazz Combos. They will also continue to have the opportunity to audition for music festivals.



Which instruments are offered?

What types of lessons are offered?

- Private lessons
- Semi-private lessons - *students can take lessons with a partner*

When do private/semi private lessons meet?

Lessons meet for a half hour once per week for the entire school year Monday-Thursday between the hours of 3:30 pm and 9:00 pm.

Milton High School

Who teaches lessons?

- Lessons are taught by professional musicians
- The Applied Lesson Program is coordinated with an instrumental curriculum taught by the in-school directors

How much does it cost?

- **Private lessons:** \$420 for Session 1 (*15 lessons at \$25.00; registration fee of \$45*)
- **Semi-private lessons:** \$270.00 per student (*15 lessons at \$15.00; registration fee of \$45*)

How do I secure an instrument?
