**Mass. Audubon: Monarch Butterflies and Their Amazing Migration, Ages 3-8**

**10:00 AM- 11:00 PM**

Learn about nature, make a clay sculpture, and have fun at the library! Each child will learn about the exciting ways in which monarch butterflies migrate thousands of miles each year. The program will begin with a story about butterflies and their migration habits and will feature a digital microscope where the children will get to examine butterflies up close. Each child will then create their own butterfly using air-dry clay. Registration required.
