

Milton Community Concerts presents “A Message of Music”, featuring the Boston City Singers 35-Voice Tour Choir. This free concert will take place on Sunday, April 28th at 3pm at First Parish of Milton (535 Canton Avenue), and will feature music and dance from around the world. Also performing will be the Croatian musical ensemble PAJDASI (“buddies, best friends”), a Boston-based tamburitza band and vocal chorus performing Croatian village and popular folk songs and dance tunes.

The Boston City Singers Tour Choir, for ages 12-18, is under the direction of founding artistic director Jane Money. This remarkable group of singers from Greater Boston compose songs, continue their vocal studies, prepare music in many languages in 2-9 parts, and take regular dance/movement and improvisation classes. The Tour Choir travels internationally in alternating years to expand their cultural, historical, and geographic knowledge, and perform in concerts and festivals. This summer they will travel to Croatia, Bosnia-Herzegovina, and the Czech Republic, where music has been used to address social justice issues throughout the centuries.

Admission to the concert is free. The audience will have an opportunity to support this upcoming tour through a free-will offering. The venue is accessible, and there is ample free parking.
