Older children, ages 6-12 ( Oct. 26th 2:30 PM)** can adopt a spider book from the exhibit in which to write a story. Participants will fill out an info sheet about their spider and their story. Decorated books will be hung up in the Children's Room for the remainder of the exhibit.
