# Milton School Committee - 2016-2017 District Goals

- Identify and implement strategies to address the social, emotional and mental health issues that impact student academic achievement by June 2017. Utilize the DESE “Whole Child, Whole School” framework to develop and deliver on-going support, programs and initiatives.
- Narrow academic proficiency gaps for sub-groups by 25% and increase college matriculation rates by June 2017.
- Develop and utilize differentiated instruction practices such as extension projects, differentiated literature in the same classroom, online coursework, Honors/AP Blend courses and Community College courses to increase the rigor of the Milton High School Honors and College Prep levels by 2018.

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- Ensure that 15% of all new teacher openings are filled by well-qualified candidates of color by the commencement of the 2017-2018 school year.
- Increase the athletic participation of African-American students and other students of color by 5% by June 2017.
- Develop and execute a Digital Technology strategy for enhancing and improving academic achievement for Grades K-5 with a pilot encompassing 1 or 2 grades ready for implementation by the opening of the 2017-2018 school year.
