This course covers elements and principles of design, history of fashion and adornment, fabric and textiles in fashion, and the color wheel. Students are introduced to the basic skills required to sew including operating sewing equipment, selecting and preparing patterns, and completing various sewing projects. Projects will include a variety of seams and bags, an infinity scarf, napkins, hand sewing, tee shirts, and a community service project. Purchasing materials for some projects may be required. The course is enhanced through lab work, guest speakers and computer labs.
