Lessons will include exploration of materials, art history, elements and principles of design, cultures, and contemporary art from around the world. Students will work both independently and collaborate as a reflection of how artists around the world and throughout history work.

Student objectives

Students will be able to

- Recognize that art is all around me.
- View artwork in a variety of settings
- Examine artwork from different cultures and time periods
- Recognize that art crosses disciplines.
- Use art words in a classroom discussion.
- Create artworks from imagination and real life.
- Create drawings that explore line qualities, combine shapes and experiment with texture and pattern.
- Create paintings that mix primary colors and explore various paint mediums and tools.
- Create prints using a stamping process.
- Create sculptures using paper techniques to cut, tear, fold and bend.
- Create clay pinch forms.
- Create artworks using mixed media.
- Identify and develop quality craftsmanship.
