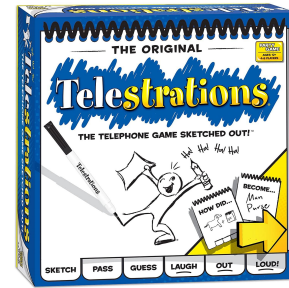
TIC TAC TOE!!

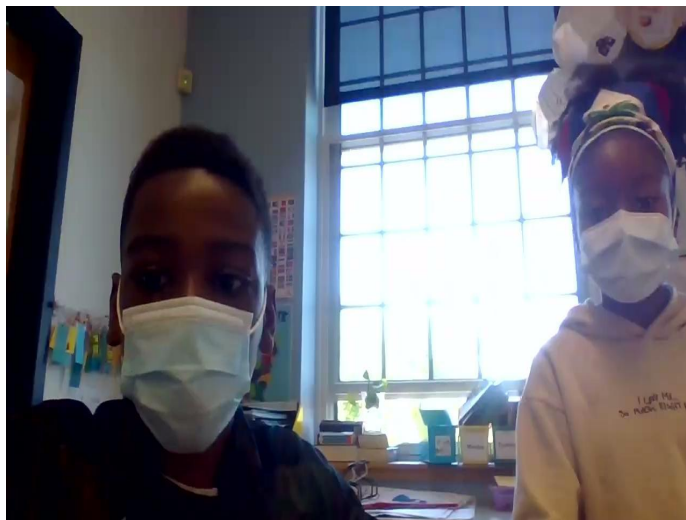
