

THE SETUP

- The athletes perform on a custom-made mobile ramp set, including a box-jump and quarter-pipe.
- The ramps can be set-up outside or in the gym in about 45 minutes.
- The tour travels to a new school every day
- Students have the opportunity to experience the action up close and the chance to meet the athletes.

WHAT IS THE ASA HIGH SCHOOL TOUR?

The ASA High School Tour travels across the US visiting 175 high schools to share a bullying-prevention and mental health awareness message at no cost to the school or District. The program brings top X Games BMX athletes to perform on a custom-made set of ramps. This is the Tour's 22nd year and has positively affected more than 4 million students.



WHAT ARE THE SHOWS LIKE?

The shows are super high energy and captivate students while our emcee shares important bullying prevention information, tools and techniques. The athletes don't hold back and you can expect to see a combination of technical tricks and big air.



HOW IS THIS EVENT FREE FOR SCHOOLS?

The Tour is funded by the US Marine Corps and ASA Entertainment. The goal of the program is to unify students to prevent bullying in schools and to raise awareness as to the massive impact of the issue nationwide.
