The mission of the Milton Public Schools is to educate, challenge, and empower all students to be productive, caring and contributing members of society.

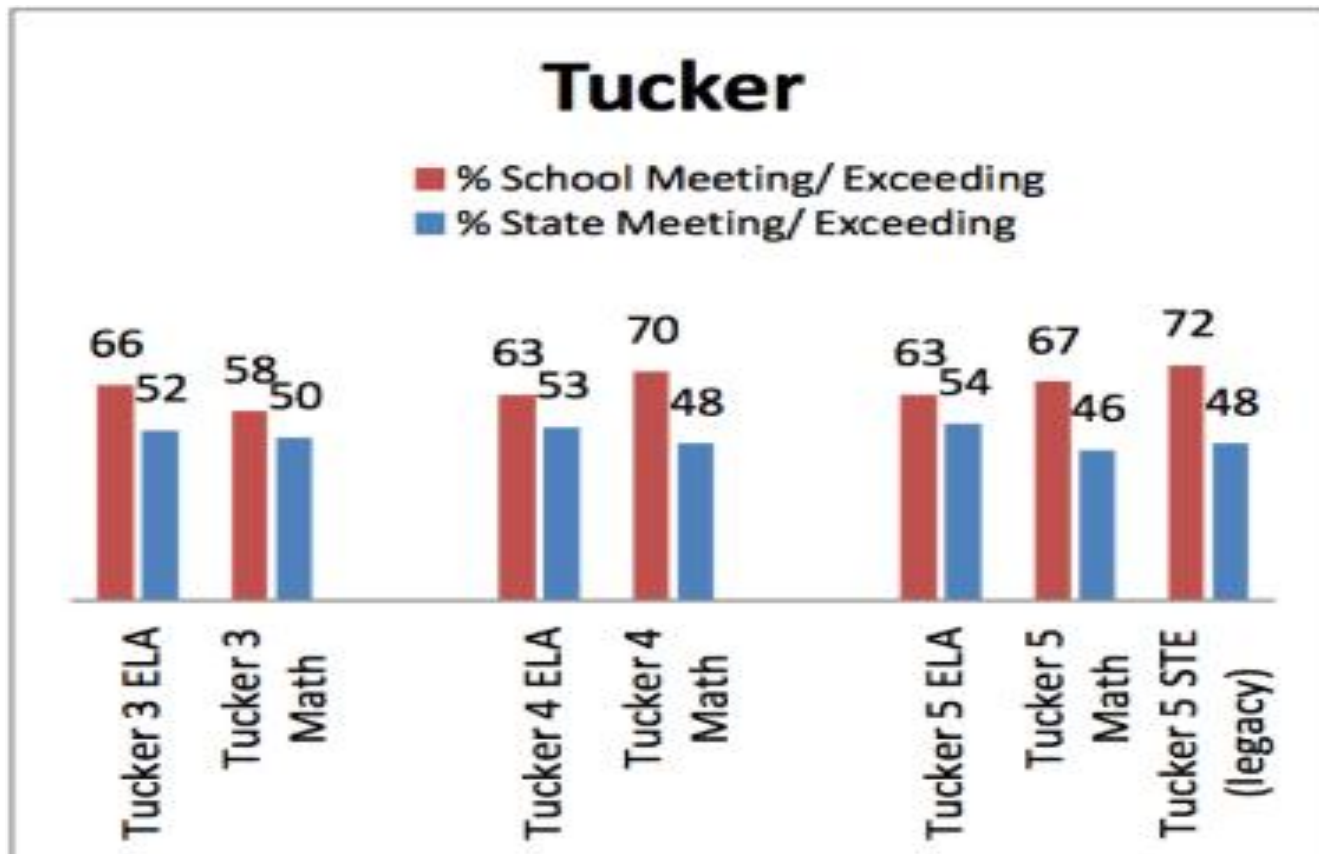
Who we are:

Goal 1-As part of the district's improvement plan for high academic achievement for all students, we will work to increase the number of students scoring in the meeting and exceeding category on state assessments in all subgroups.

2018-2019

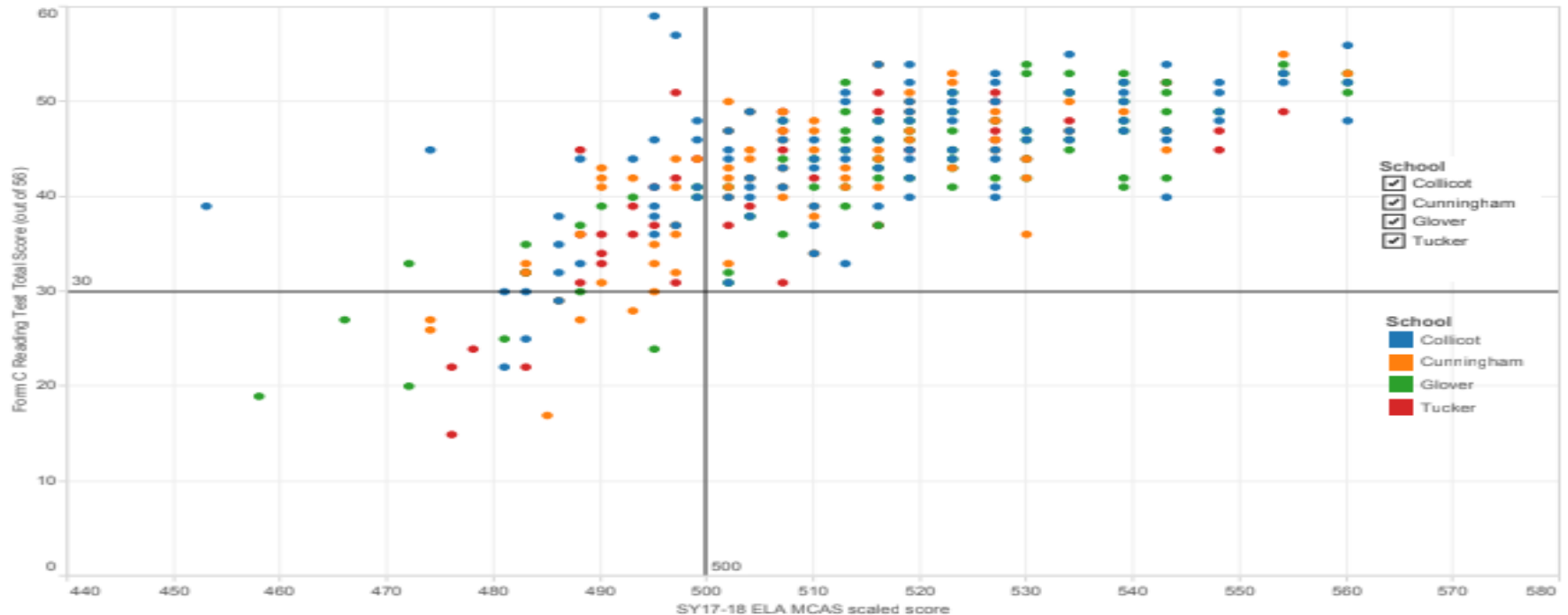


Tucker School Goal 2 MCAS

Tucker School Goal 2 Progress

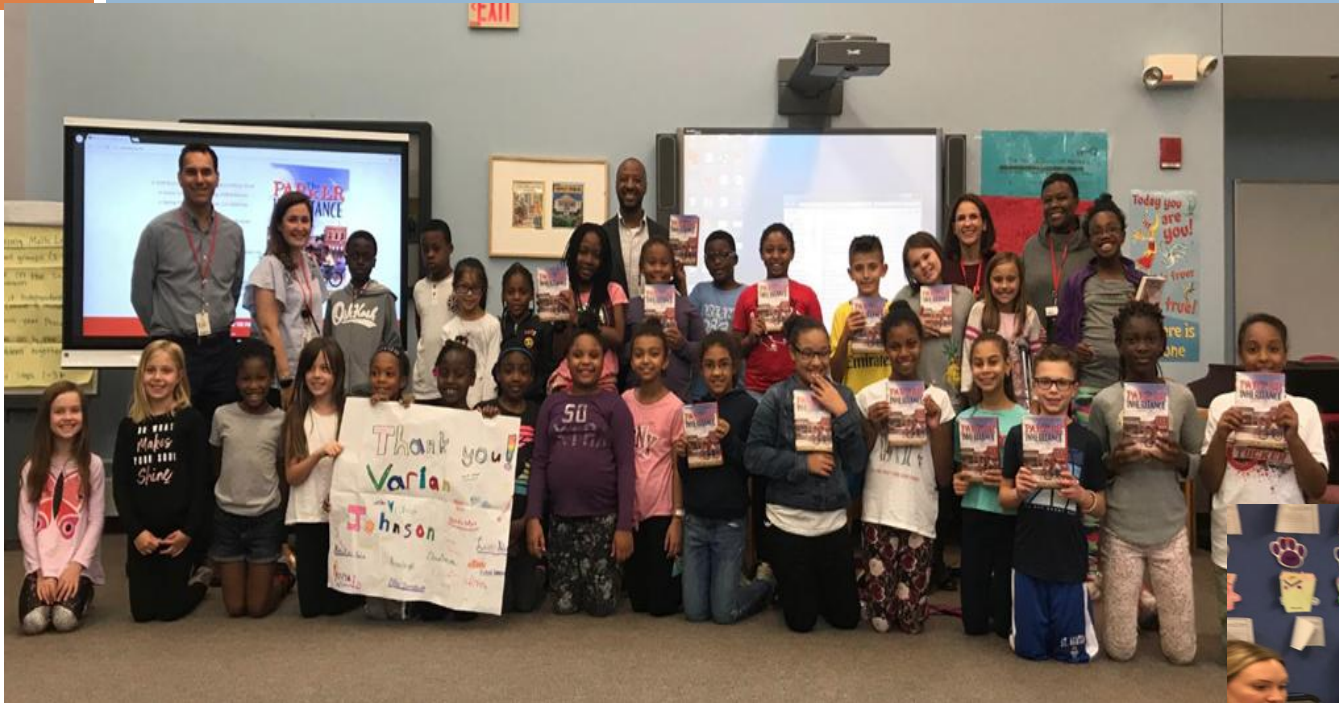
2017-2018

2018-2019

Goal 3-Tucker School will develop a community of respect, collaboration and achievement amongst all stakeholders to ensure the optimal learning environment for student success.

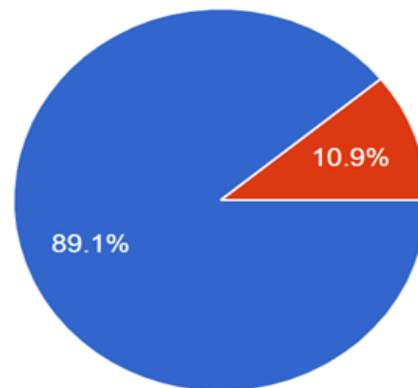

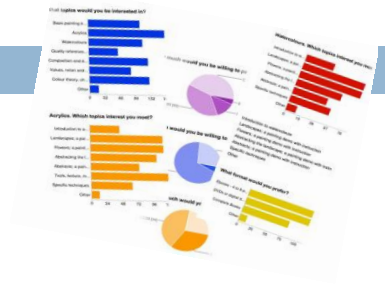
