### **Important Information:**

The following classes are available for students registered for ASE by December 20. Spaces are limited. Classes will begin the week of January 6. Students must be registered for ASE on the day class takes place. No refunds or credits will be issued after Jan. 10. Please note LEC activities are NOT scheduled on early release days or school closings. Cancellations due to snow days will be rescheduled at the end of the Winter session.

### How to Register:

We are excited to announce that we are now offering the convenience of online registration through FamilyID (www.familyid.com). FamilyID is a secure registration platform that provides you with an easy, user-friendly way to sign-up for LEC Programs, and helps us to be more administratively efficient and environmentally responsible. When you register through FamilyID, the system keeps track of your information in your FamilyID profile. You enter your information only once for each family member for multiple uses and multiple programs.

#### FAMILY ID REGISTRATION PROCESS

- 1. To find your program, click on the link provided above, scroll down and select your *Limited Enrollment Classes* (*LEC*) according to your child's school.
- Next click on the blue *Register Now* button and scroll, if necessary, to the *Create Account/Log In* green buttons. If this is your first time using FamilyID, click *Create Account*. Click *Log In*, if you already have a FamilyID account.
- 3. Create your secure FamilyID account by entering the account owner First and Last names (parent/guardian), Email address and password. Select *I Agree* to the FamilyID Terms of Service. Click Create Account.
- 4. You will receive an email with a link to activate your new account. (If you don't see the email, check your E-mail filters (spam, junk, etc.).
- 5. Click on the link in your activation E-mail, which will log you in to FamilyID.com
- 6. Once in the registration form, complete the information requested. All fields with a red\* are required to have an answer.
- 7. Click the *Continue* button when your form is complete.
- 8. Review your registration summary.
- 9. Click the green Submit button. **\*\*YOU ARE NOT DONE AFTER CLICKING SUBMIT. THERE IS ONE MORE STEP!**
- 10. Your registration is NOT complete unless payment is received through Unibank
- 11. After submitting on Family ID, you will be redirected to the Unibank website or you can visit Unibank under Community Schools; "ASE payments only" option and in the comments section, please type "LEC WINTER"
- 12. You will get a confirmation email from both Family ID and Unibank after payment is made. If you completed the steps above correctly, your child(ren) should be all set unless we contact you






