 - Numbers are down
 - Reported to state 4 staff and 7 students tested positive for Covid
 - Will continue with the at home testing kits throughout the summer and early fall until the test run out

Superintendent Jette

- Thanked all the parents and guardians at Pierce Middle School for their support during the lockdown at Pierce Middle School last Friday
- Scheduled a call for all parents on Sunday night
- Three live 9mm bullets found in three different bathrooms, no gun found on site
- The fear, anxiety and disruption is very real and unfortunate
- The bigger issue is where a middle school student can access live 9mm bullets and bring them into the school
- Remind parents by law to lock up weapons and ammunition if you have a license to carry arms
- Understand the communication is important and to reach out to their children to see if they are safe
- Please don't rely on social media for information
- Please don't come to the school and ask for your cooperation and allow the first responders to do their job
- Will continue to support students and staff
- We want students to be seen, heard and feel valued

Member Ross Denny

- Has a child at the Middle School and appreciates how well the situation was handled
- Want to thank the administration and police and everyone who showed up to create a safe environment for our kids
- Surprised the emotions we saw, expected kids to be crying but what was more upsetting is the indifference, this is their new normal and what they except
- Recognize anything can happen, we have gone too far in our society if our kids are now comfortable with a lockdown
- We are asking too much of our educators and now we are asking too much of our students, we need to do better

Superintendent Jette

- Reconvening our security meetings
- Work with former Sergeant Jack Richmond specialist Norfolk County Swat Team
- Milton Police Department partnership
- A lot of parents want to know the details of the security plan but we do not share our plan since we do not want to compromise our security measures in place
- Goal is to be prepared and use your best judgment

Dr. Miranda

- Asking parents to stay away is a safety measure but tough for parents emotionally
- What would the protocol be to acknowledge parents and their concerns? It is a parent's first response to run to the school
- How can we have a plan in place to acknowledge the reality of parents wanting to be there for their child?
- See something, say something helping young people understand

Superintendent Jette

- More than 300 concerned parents on Central Ave. on the day of the lock down
- Did walk over and give the parents updates
- Parents respected the boundaries and appreciative during the lockdown
- Always remind your kids you are responsible for what you have in your bag
