Member White

• Reporting is anonymous, are the parents filling out the reports with their child?

• Are we getting reports from the principals when a parent calls with incidents?

Dr. McKinney

- Yes, there are circumstances when parents are calling the school directly and the Principals are responding quickly
- Yes, there are instances where students are identifying themselves, and they are also reports done anonymously and we have to do our due diligence
- Following up with all reports to make sure our students feel safe

Dr. Carroll

- Primary data shared from the Coalition, this data is a drastic under reporting
- Assumption is those higher numbers are more accurate than the lower number with the surveys
- Disparities of where the reports are coming from?
 - Are multiple reports coming from the same people?
 - Are there ways to track?
- How is the form being communicated to families?
 - How do they know it exists?
 - What is the expectation?
- Middle School and High School should be awareness that this form exist

Dr. McKinney

- Thank you for the feedback
- This work is fluid
- Want to intervene right away
- Marrying internal and external data
- Need to be consistent
- Will continue to work with our building leaders

Member Ross Denny

- Secondary level there is a highlight that students are self reporting
- Communicate with the students
