7. Strategic Planning Advisory Committee Report - Dr. Miranda

- Highlighted that this particular year we have focused a lot on training
- How do we up the capacity of our school leaders and educators to make sure we can obtain our goals we have set?
- Do need to remind ourselves it takes time
- Equity and Learning
 - o Number of forums have been held for the community
 - Building the capacity of our staff internally and the community
 - extending the learning
 - Restorative Justice Training offered during Professional Development
 - These practices are starting to show up in different ways in school buildings and put into practice
 - Capacity building for teachers and students
 - Work continues to be on track
 - Spoke with Director Claire Galloway-Jones
 - This is a marathon and not a sprint
 - Staff needs to have a sense of belonging in the district
 - Recruitment
 - Looking to attract diverse educators
 - Waiting on the AP Data
 - Looking at the enrollment
 - How are we progressing?
 - DEI Website coming soon
 - Looking to add a Diversity Coach for next year to move this work forward
- Personalized Learning
 - Progress is being made
 - o Building capacity across all grades
 - Use of data reviewed
 - Universal Training coming part of the common language
 - Building Websites that would focus on personalized learning for staff and families
 - Approach to teaching
- Safe and Supporting Schools
 - o Calm Classroom Trainings have been completed
 - o Implementation Calm Classrooms K-12
 - High School implementation has been a challenge
- Additional funding has been secured for SEL work
- Continue to make sure we have our SEL coaches at each school

- Health and Wellness Committee piloting of the Michigan Model
 - o Implementation is difficult due to the time in the day
 - Who is responsible for teaching
- Trauma Sensitive work is happening
- How do we do a better job tracking data in relation to our strategic goals? Work has been slower than hoped
- Transitioning to Power Schools System Data Management
 - Will go live next school year
- All the work is commendable and we are making progress

Member Loring

- Are the Calm Classrooms, Restorative Justice and the Michigan Model new this year for Professional Development?
- Are surveys given to staff regarding PD days?
- Who is providing the feedback regarding the implementations?

Dr. McKinney

- Yes to the Calm Classroom and Michigan Model being new this year for Professional Development
- Restorative Justice has been implemented in the past
- Yes, surveys go out to staff after the PD days for feedback
- We have a district PD committee that reviews the surveys
- Unit B members, Restorative Justice Coach, Directors, Department Heads, Principals, Coordinators and SEL Leads all work together

Dr. Carroll

- Reminder about the transition to Power Schools
 - Is it possible to get an update at a School Committee meeting to learn and understand what this transition means?
 - There could be questions from the community as well

Dr. McKinney

• Yes, we can put that together a presentation for a School Committee meeting

Member Qiu

• Is there a reason why we use Power School instead of Google Classroom?

Dr. McKinney

- Power School will be the new information system
 - Will talk to Google Classroom
- Can provide more information at the presentation

8. Safety and Security Advisory Committee Report - Member Varghese

- Met last Wednesday
- Current Safety and Security process has been going well
- All staff have gone through training
- New staff will receive training at the start of the school year
- Concerns over desk and chairs in the stairwells at Cunningham via social media
 - Confirmed that this was only temporary due to the flooding in the classrooms
- Clarify the language around the social media policy to avoid confusion
- Fire Department walks through the schools with the custodian staff at the beginning of each year
 - o Going forward will bring in the Principals
 - o Then communicate to all staff
- Two rooms that flooded at Cunningham have had issues with water in the past
- This has been addressed and an alarm system has been added
- Sprinklers and alarms are tested regularly
- Talked about safety measures and fire safety precautions
- Security team discussed using blackboard, keeping staff updated especially during lockdowns
 - There are a few dead zones in certain areas of the buildings
 - Working on the issue, perhaps using two way radios
- Software upgrades for visitors coming into the schools
- Discussion of door sensors that were included in the budget

Member Loring

• Asked about the dead zones? No cell phone service?

Member Varghese

- Confirmed yes, there are areas without cell service and the cafeteria when it is loud, staff can't hear the speakers/announcements
- Working on solutions to these issues
