I hope you had an enjoyable and restful summer. As we look forward to the upcoming school year, we will be using a new organization, called [ArxE](#), for mandated training rather than having the legal overview on our opening day. ArxE was co-founded by a former school administrator with fifteen years of experience and provides training to over 70 school districts in Massachusetts.

This new online platform will keep track of all training, monitor completion, and communicate directly to each of our faculty members and staff. There are updated training/videos that can be done at your own pace. The platform will also have links to completing any additional district based policy sign-off forms.

We are in the process of testing this software on a pilot group, and we hope to share it with the rest of you within the first two weeks of September. Each building principal will allot an hour of time for you to complete this training either during a faculty meeting or another designated time.

Later in mid-September, you should be receiving two separate emails from ArxE. The first email will instruct you how to set up your account, and the second will take you to the mandated training web page and give you a completion date for training. If you do not receive these emails, please check your spam folder and let me know at your earliest convenience.
