Behavior Policy

Expectations:

- obey the staff and show respect to adults and other students
- show respect for school property and for the property of others
- refrain from disruption: loud talking, yelling, throwing things, etc.
- do not fight or harm other students
- exhibit good sportsmanship
- use appropriate and respectful language
- remain with staff at all times unless given permission otherwise
- do not verbally, emotionally, or physically bully others

Consequences:

<u>1st incident</u>: Student will be removed from the activity or class. Supervisor will send a written report home to the parent/guardian detailing the incident, appropriate behavior, and consequences. Written report must be returned, signed by a parent or guardian, with child on the next day attending any Milton Community Schools program or be refused admission.

<u>2nd incident</u>: Supervisor will send a written report home to the parent/guardian detailing the incident, appropriate behavior, and consequences. Parent/guardian must meet with the MCS Supervisor. <u>3rd incident</u>: Supervisor will prepare written report detailing the incident, appropriate behavior, and consequences. Parent/guardian will be called, and parent or parent designee must arrive <u>within 20 minutes</u> to remove the student for the duration of the day. Written report must be returned, signed by a parent or guardian, with child on the next day attending ASE.

4th incident: Mandatory one week suspension. No tuition reimbursement for suspended days.

5th incident: Withdrawal from MCS. No tuition reimbursement.

In the case of severe disruption at any consequence level caused by a child's behavior or behavior which causes safety concerns, the parent/guardian will be contacted by phone and must remove the student for the remainder of the day. The Program Director may take further action, including suspension or removal, determined on individual review of the incident. Based on the severity of the incident, the school Guidance Counselor and Principal may be notified. These procedures are in addition to consequences listed above.
