Notes from Nurse LeBlanc:

GI virus: The number of cases of the stomach bug are slowly increasing. Symptoms may include nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, stomach pain, headaches and/or fever. Please keep your child home from school if they are experiencing any of these symptoms. People should be without symptoms for a full 24 hours before returning to work or school. Please reinforce proper hand hygiene especially after using the bathroom and especially before eating, preparing or handling food.

Strep Throat & Conjunctivitis: Scattered cases are present in the school. People need to be on antibiotics for a full 24 hours for before returning to school to help prevent the spread of these germs.

Flu Vaccine: It's not too late to get the flu vaccine. The CDC recommends a yearly flu vaccine as the first and most important step in protecting against flu viruses. Flu vaccination can reduse flu illnesses, health care provider visits and missed school and work due to flu. Please refer to the CDC.gov website for more information.

Communication with Nurse: Please consider notifying or copying the nurse on any medical information and injuries that may impact your child's school day. A note from a health care provider is needed if your child has any activity restrictions due to injury. A note is also needed when your child is cleared to return to all academic and physical activities including PE and recess.

SEPAC News: The Milton SEPAC is pleased to announce our first in a series of Parent Speak events. On January 17th from 6:30 to 8:30, the SEPAC will host Glover parents in the Keys Community Room at the Milton Public Library. Join us to share experiences, ask questions, and express any concerns. Parents will also have the opportunity to ask questions about the IEP process, parent rights, and other aspects of special education services.
