Health Tips from Nurse LeBlanc:

- 1. Allergy season is upon us! Over the counter nose sprays and antihistamines are helpful on a regular basis. Try to start allergy medications a few weeks before allergy season peaks or at the first sign of a runny nose & itchy eyes. Daily allergy meds are not given in the nurse's office.
- 2. Try to follow the pollen count for the day. Pollen counts are highest between the hours of 10am to 4pm. Close your windows. The fresh air feels great but it carries pollen in from outdoors and spreads it around the house. Removing shoes and wiping off pets fur before entering the house help decrease the spread of pollen.
- 3. Be aware of the heat and UV index. Please apply sunscreen before school and be sure your child has a labeled water bottle and hat daily for sun protection.
- 4.
