It was a wonderful week! We welcomed our newest Glover Kids into the family and had so much fun! Here are a few updates as we look forward to next week:

**LIVE Drop Off Line:** This week, Mrs. MacNeil and I have been supporting our younger students as they transition into the school building in the doorway. Next week, I'll be monitoring car line closely. In order for drop off to run smoothly and efficiently, it is *imperative* that all drivers remain in their vehicles with their engines running. There is absolutely no parking in the live drop off line. We will assist you in getting your children out of your vehicle and it is helpful if you situate them on the right side of the car so that they can slide right out with the assistance of a staff member. We ask you to respect this process and remember that if you need to park your vehicle and walk your child up to the building, you cannot park in the drop off circle. Please let anyone who may be dropping your child off (sitters, grandparents, etc.) know so that they are aware. We are also distributing the orange pick up cards so that we can safely monitor students as they get into vehicles. Please keep this orange card handy so that you can slide it onto your dash board. We appreciate your partnership in making the smoothest, safest, and most efficient drop off line possible.

<u>School Hours and Tardiness</u>: We know that construction has made arrival and departure from Glover a bit difficult. It is our hope that the DPW will be able to resolve this soon. Starting next week, we will begin marking students tardy. Instruction begins in classrooms at 8:50am. Please know that if you arrive after this time, your child is missing something in the classroom. We understand that there are extenuating circumstances but as a matter of practice, please try to arrive before 8:50. If you do arrive after 8:50, please come into the building to sign your child in. Next week, we will adjust timing according to traffic and construction and <u>not</u> mark children tardy if they are late due to difficulty getting to the school.
