## The student or staff member who tested positive should:









**Stay Home** 

Notify the school and close contacts

Monitor symptoms

Assist the school/ Health Department with contact tracing

The positive student or staff member will need to stay in isolation for at least 10 days AND until they have been fever free for 24 hours AND experienced improvment in symptoms AND received clearance from public health authority contact tracers.

## Once notified of the positive, the district will:

The District will determine if the student or staff member was on the premises during the period when transmission is possible and promptly close off and disinfect any impacted areas.

The District will determine if the student or staff member was on the premises during the period when transmission is possible and if so, will begin in-school contact tracing.

The District will prepare communications for both close contacts and the school community, with efforts to protect the positive individual's identity.
