Winter PASS classes will begin the week of February 7, 2022 and run for eight sessions. Each PASS class costs \$50. Below is a list of the PASS classes being offered:

D & D Club (Fridays with Ms. Dow)...Join us as we create adventures and fun fantasy characters! No experience necessary, but if you've always wanted to play Dungeons and Dragons or similar games come join the party.

Guitar Club (Wednesdays with Mr. Ortiz)...All students advanced and beginners (electric or acoustic) are welcome to join the Guitar Club. The club is designed to learn guitar skills and techniques.

Mindful Coloring (Thursdays with Ms. Monahan)...If you enjoy coloring and are looking for an activity to help reduce stress and relax your mind after a busy day, then mindful coloring is for you! 
