GRADE 9 COURSE SELECTION

On March 3, MHS Counselors showed the course selection video to 8th graders in assembly, explained scheduling process, then answered questions. Course recommendations are now available in Plus Portals. Course selections must be completed by March 11. Follow the instructions below to complete the process.

- Read the <u>Program of Studies</u> to determine what courses your child wants to take in 9th grade. Pay attention to prerequisites on the 9th grade course selection sheet.
- Have a conversation with your child about choosing appropriate courses and levels for grade 9
- If you have questions about course recommendations, you and/or your child should contact the teacher directly.
- Watch the Course Selection "How to" Video.
- Attend the Program of Studies Night virtually @ 6:00 pm on March 8 if you have any questions.
- You and your child should select courses and submit them via Plus Portals by March 11. Your child's courses must add up to 35 credits
- Verification forms will be emailed home to all students/ guardians on March 18.
- If your child needs to make any class changes, do the following by March 25:
 - print the verification sheet
 - mark the changes
- return sheet to Mrs. Veldran

Student schedules will be available on Plus Portals in August.

HEALTH INFORMATION

Massachusetts mandated school-based screenings will begin in the next few weeks and continue throughout the school year. If your child is followed by a specialist, has already had some of these screenings done this year, or if you choose not to have your child screened, please email Nurse Perry at bperry@miltonps.org to OPT OUT. Please include your child's full name and the screening they are being excused from.

- Grade 7...Vision, BMI, Height Weight, SBIRT,
- Grades 6, 7 and 8...Scoliosis

These screenings are a tool to indicate if there is a need for further evaluation and not meant to provide a definite diagnosis.
