Dierce's Amazing Artists

Mr. Manning's 6th grade artists were studying contemporary artists who use maps in their work. Cartography is the process of creating and drawing maps. I had the 6th graders search up their neighborhood on several mapping sights and use a birds eye view to create a map of where they live. I put a twist on this assignment by having the students draw their map in the shape of their profile. It made the assignment more personal and more connected to each artist. I used a spotlight to trace their profile and the students did the rest. The results are amazing and you may even see your own neighborhood so look close. Great way to end the year!









7th and 8th grade artists finished the year strong with a very difficult color wheel assignment and more Pop Art. 7th and 8th grade artists learned how to manipulate the color wheel and how most designers use a color wheel on a daily basis. We examined NBA uniforms and NFL jerseys to get a glimpse of color schemes and which teams used complimentary colors and which teams used analogous color schemes.
