

Good Afternoon,

I hope this letter finds everyone healthy and doing well. I imagine you are all looking forward to the summer months and nice weather.

I have arranged for a curbside, minimal contact, medication pick up on Friday, June 12 from 9:30 -11:30 am. I will be sitting at a table outside of the main entrance to Pierce Middle School, (weather permitting, otherwise just in the front door). Please respond to me at bperry@miltonps.org with your students name, medication to be picked up and who is authorized to pick up the medication, so I will have it ready.

Any epipens, inhalers, seizure and over the counter medication will be handed back and noted in the students health chart as to who it was returned to.

Control substances, such as stimulant medication, must be returned to an adult and proper pill count must be signed for. I will have individual pens and paperwork ready at pickup.

I will arrange another pick up date during the last week of school on June 22 and will notify you of the time in a later note. All medication that is not picked up during these two designated pick up times will be disposed of as of June 24.

Please let me know if you do not wish to pick up medication and would like it disposed of.
